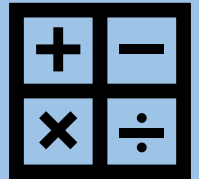
## Grade 9 Math (De-Streamed) beginning September 2021

- Grade 9 Applied Math and Grade 9 Academic will no longer be offered starting in September 2021
- Grade 9 Math (Course Code: MTH 1WO) will be offered for all grade 9 students
- Locally Developed Math (MAT 1L1) will still be offered for students in grade 9
- The Math Prep Course (GLE 1OM) will also still be offered for students in grade 9 as an intervention course taken in Semester 1 (prior to Grade 9 Math) to help strengthen foundational math concepts and improve learning skills and work habits



## Grade 9 Summer Math Prep Course

- 10 math concepts will be covered
  - 5 key concepts will review grade 8 material
  - 5 key concepts will introduce grade 9 material
- Topics will include fractions, integers, solving equations, ratios and rates, and other important curriculum expectations.
- Will include a blend of synchronous and asynchronous learning so access to an electronic device each morning is required.
- The same program will be offered from July 19-30 and August 9-20 (9am-1pm daily).
